Notification

It is for information of all concerned that to enhance the quality of results of the students in JEE (Mains and Advance), NEET and other important entrance examinations in the premier institutes of the country, Govt. of Tripura launched a scheme namely 'Super 30'. Under this scheme, top 30 Madhyamik passed students of TBSE maintaining (100 point roster of the State Government) will be sent to different leading coaching institutes at their choice to prepare them for the aforesaid entrance. This year (2021-22), it is decided to conduct a selection test (written test) to select above mentioned 30 students.

Modalities related to conducting this selection test is as follows:

Date of test: 21.09.2021 (flexible under extraordinary situations).

Time: 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. (30 minutes compensatory time for candidates with benchmark disabilities)

Date of notification: 27.08.21

Publication of result: Within 30.09.21

All the questions will be MCQs with four options. There will be one correct option.


Syllabus of the Test: TBSE Madhyamik Science and Mathematics syllabus-2021.

Reservation: 31% Scholarship will be reserved for students belonging to the ST category, 17% for SC category including 4% for Physically Challenged group students.

Students belonging to SC/ST/Physically Challenged Group will be required to submit the SC/ST/PH certificate issued by the competent authority.

Eligibility:

- Minimum 70% Cut off marks in aggregate to be obtained by the applicant in TBSE Madhyamik Board examination -2021
- Maximum family income of the applicant from all sources will be below 8 lakhs per annum.
